Jack Brown noted that the City's share of the potential geological study needed for the planned 4 5 Army Corps of Engineers analysis of the harbor north cliff and stabilization could be \$20,000. It was 6 agreed to further discuss this during review of the Harbor Fund. 7 8 Parks Capital Improvement Reserve Fund (Page 8) 9 There were no proposed changes to this fund. 10 11 **City Hall Restoration Reserve Fund (Page 9)** 12 There was discussion about the condition of city hall and whether money should be spent to maintain 13 the current building vs. going after funding for a new building.
