Mayor White called the meeting to order and established a quorum at 6:00 pm.

Presentation by TCB Security Services, Inc.

Mike Geoff, CEO and Patrick Dougherty, Director of Operations of TCB, Inc. introduced themselves. Geoff narrated a powerpoint presentation which provided information on the services available through TCB Security Services. (copy of brochures attached to the original of these minutes) Geoff said the service is patrol, not enforcement, and he'd like to begin a presence in Depoe Bay. They offer a variety of services including patrol, parking enforcement, code enforcement, alarm response, vacation watch, special events security. Clients are able to customize their contracts by including only the services they need. Options for patrol services are either an officer assigned to the city on a set schedule, or officers on patrol driving through the city 6 – 7 times a night. Their officers can issue citations only on non-moving violations (parking tickets), which either the city or TCB can collect. It was suggested that the city could include the vacation watch service in a contract and then charge residents for "house checks" (vacation, absentee owners). It was also suggested to develop an RFP, identifying services the city requires/desires, to obtain proposals.

It was agreed to schedule another workshop meeting to discuss the matter further on Tuesday, February 16th at 6:00 pm.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:45 pm.
