    Mayor White called the meeting to order and established a guorum at 6:00 PM.

17 II. DRAFT SDC AND RATE STUDY
18 Mr. Henry and Ms. Lombard reviewed the draft water and wastewater rate study. Points

   covered included: There is a need for a relatively sharp increase in rates, followed by a

   consistent annual increase. Depoe Bay water rates are currently far below the state
21
    average, which is $45.00 for 7,500 gallons usage per month for water per residential
22
    house. Proposed Wastewater base rates do not include any usage; the same structure as
23
    water billing was recommended (pay for all usage). Murray asked about the City's policy
24
    of averaging summer months' sewer bills based on winter months' usage; the
25
   recommendation was to simplify – again, pay for what is actually used every billing cycle.
   The engineers recommended covering 110% of operational costs. They will put together
26

    an information sheet for the public hearing, which was scheduled for June 15. They will
28
    attend the public hearing. It was the consensus of the Council to publicize the public
    hearing well. A workshop to discuss the Master Plan and SDCs was scheduled for 5:30 PM
