Parks Commission members and City Superintendent Owings walked the Nature Trail to view the recent work completed by the Lincoln County Jail Crew on the trail extension project. Discussion included signage, gravel, and bridges during the walk and everyone agreed the jail crew has done a good job.

Owings reported on other matters: The new linoleum is installed in the Community Hall bathrooms and hallway.

The bus barn reroofing is completed. The State Parks Department grant application for the Oregon Coast Trail was submitted, with letters of support provided by the city and a number of individuals. Drainage issues at the City Park gazebo will be addressed later this spring. The new picnic tables have been assembled by the city crew with the exception of the ADA tables which arrived with wrong parts. A failed attempt to obtain correct parts has led to the crew fabricating parts to complete the assembly of these tables. All are stored at the Wastewater Treatment Facility on Southpoint St. City Planner Larry Lewis is ill and won't be able to attend the regular meeting at 5:30 pm.

Everyone agreed to cancel the regular meeting at 5:30 PM since the City Planner was not available, and because of muddy boots from the walk.
