37 Lewis summarized his Memo (copy attached to original of these Minutes). A Commissioner asked
38 Lewis to identify the number of Lots. Lewis clarified that the Applicant/Owner recently completed the
39 reestablishment of 2 Tax Lot Lines (creating 3 Lots) through the Lincoln County Assessors Office and a
40 Property Line Adjustment on the Subject Lot.

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38 VII. CITY COUNCIL LIAISON REPORT

39 Connors reported the Council moved to table Adoption of Proposed Ordinance #279 (Amending
40 Ordinance #24 as Amended, Retail Commercial Zone Sections 3.110(3)(e) and 3.110(4); Off-Street
41 Parking and Off-Street Loading Requirements Section 4.030; and Declaring an Emergency) until the
42 first Meeting in December. Mayor White advised the Council he has a Meeting with the Director of
43 O.D.O.T. and O.D.O.T. Staff on November 9th and will ask for input from them regarding Highway
44 Parking Limitations.

1 VIII. PLANNER'S REPORT

2 Lewis reviewed his Report (copy attached to the original of these Minutes). A Commissioner asked
3 about the status of the Halvorson-Mason Tract "D" Development. Lewis responded that the Expedited
4 Land Division Application identified six Two-Family Residential Dwellings (a total of 12 Residential
5 Dwellings) but there has been rumor that may change. A Commissioner expressed concern regarding
6 the debris, logs, etc. from the Pre-Development Activity and asked if the City could require the
7 Contractor to clean-up the Subject Site. Lewis said he would verify if the City had any method of
8 enforcement. A Commissioner stated that the Developer of View of the Bay sent Letters to the
9 Contractors/Builders insisting they Clean-Up their Construction Sites or be subject to a Fine.
