

City of Depoe Bay- Gleneden Sanitary District Wastewater Advisory Committee  
Regular Quarterly Meeting – Thursday, November 18, 2004 – 4:00 PM  
Depoe Bay Wastewater Treatment Plant

PRESENT: Bruce Silver, Pete Erickson, City Field Superintendent Terry Owings

STAFF: Plant Operator Dan Arnold, City Recorder Pery Murray

The meeting began at 4:05 PM.

Erickson reported that GSD's planned smoke testing had not occurred yet. Previously they had found an abandoned RV hookup which had been taken care of. Owings said the city had last conducted smoke testing about 8 years ago.

Owings had asked Arnold to bring flow data information from the SCADA system for discussion since it appears the numbers still are not correct. He advises that a program technician should be contacted to check the system, which could be done in the same time frame as the annual meter calibrations. Erickson suggested Owings meet with District Superintendent Snyder to discuss this.

Erickson reported the District is moving forward on the upgrade work of the two pump stations and the riprap at the park.

Owings reported: 1) That since the last meeting sludge has been hauled. Approximately 291,000 gallons was delivered to the sludge site. Neighbors of the site have submitted complaints and Owings has been in contact with them as well as DEQ. Paul Kennedy, DEQ, is planning to coordinate a meeting in an attempt to resolve the matter. There is another site available but the costs are higher. 2) The # 1 pump at Harbor Lift has been rebuilt and reinstalled, and is working okay. 3) This year's budget includes allocation for purchase of an auxiliary pump (100 hp), which would be used as a standby while pumps are offline for repair. This would eliminate the need to rent a standby pump at a cost of approximately \$2,000 per month.

Owings asked Arnold to bring the flow data to the next meeting for discussion. Erickson said he would ask Snyder to contact Owings.

The meeting ended at 4:23 PM.
