

City of Depoe Bay- Gleneden Sanitary District Wastewater Advisory Committee  
Regular Meeting – Wednesday, November 17, 2010 – 4:00 PM  
Wastewater Treatment Plant, 212 SW Southpoint St., Depoe Bay

The meeting began at 4:05 PM.

The meeting opened with introductions of those present.

Walls provided a report on treatment plant operations, noting that adjustments made to well levels (PID) have made a positive difference in the treatment process, particularly during high flows. Snyder noted the change on timing of the submersible pumps at Fogarty Creek Station, which should be helpful as well. Walls said that emergency backups are in all pump stations and backup pumps are now on hand for pump failures, eliminating the need for rentals. Owings said that with these redundancy efforts we meet DEQ requirements relating to the no-spill policy. Walls explained the alarm system and use of laptop computer by on-call operators, which is a great tool in managing operations.

#### Wastewater Master Plan Update

Snyder said the Sanitary Board members have copies of the plan and asked if a time frame has been identified. Owings referenced section 7 of the plan which provides the engineers' recommendations, saying the city and sanitary district need to discuss these recommendations. He explained the Williams Avenue alternate to Hwy 101 for replacement of the main line. The plan identifies this alternate and upgrade to Vista Lift Station as the #1 priority. Snyder said a copy of the plan has been provided to the district's engineer and they have received his response. He will provide a copy to the city.

It was agreed to meet again in the first quarter of 2011, after January.

There being no further business, meeting ended at 4:45 PM.
